Recipe for Swedish Rice Dessert

1 cup cooked rice (1/2 cup uncooked)
 Start in small amount of cold water, add about 1 pt. milk. Cook till thick and creamy. Add 1/2 tsp salt. Dissolve 1 envelope Knox gelatin in 1/4 cup cold water. Add to hot rice. Let cool until it begins to set: Whip 1 pt cream. Add 1/2 cup sugar, 1/4 tsp almond extract. Add this to rice. Place in a mold (for salad luncheon put in a bowl) Serve with raspberry sauce.
 Raspberry Sauce:
 1 (10 oz) pkg frozen raspberry 1/2 cup red currant jelly 1 1/2 tsp corn starch.
 Bring to boil and cook until clear and thickened. Slightly stran. Cool.
